Footnotes

FIRE BREAK was settled for a half mile, bid two wide to mid turn, eased out four wide into the stretch, rallied when set down for the drive and prevailed in the late stages. GREY STORM trailed to the second turn, shifted out four wide and commenced to rally, had to check when DEL MAR EXPRESS was tiring in front of him, got past that one, found room outside rivals and was closing determinedly late. COLORFUL DANCER was outrun to the backstretch, moved closer to the half, came two wide to the stretch then found room inside in upper stretch, tried to make a run in the lane but was outfinished. VOTE set all the pace for six furlongs, responded to pressure to deep stretch but tired late. SPEED ROUSER tracked the pace to the half, was roused four wide on the second turn then came up empty in the stretch. DEL MAR EXPRESS pressed the pace to the second turn, was being outrun by rivals leaving the five sixteenths, was pinched near the quarter pole and had to check into the stretch then gave out.
