OUR NAUTIQUE (NZ) was rated on the front end to the second turn, responded and edged away in upper stretch then dug in gamely late and held. BOLD CHIEFTAIN stalked the pace to the second turn, bid inside to the stretch then shifted off the rail a furlong out and closed willingly but was too late. DUNMORE EAST prompted the pace to the second turn, tried the winner nearing the three eighths, was outkicked by that one to mid stretch but kept to task in the final furlong and was also gaining. UH OH BANGO hopped at the start with the rider losing his left iron, settled after the rider regained his footing, raced two wide to the stretch and finished willingly in a game effort. HIGHWAY BANDIT had no speed, raced three or four wide throughout and did not threaten. SKIPSHOT tracked the pace for six furlongs, tried to rally three deep on the second turn but weakened through the drive.
