FULL DANCER had the best speed, led the field leaving the chute, rated on the front end to the second turn, responded to kick clear to mid stretch then held off HOLLYWOOD FREDIE late. HOLLYWOOD FREDIE The latter had no speed and trailed to the second turn, was asked for more at the three eighths and made a stout run while circling rivals four wide to the stretch then continued to respond in the drive and closed the gap steadily. HE'S CAGEY pressed the pace to the second turn, was two wide to the stretch then failed to rally in the drive. BESAME SUANCES chased the winner for six furlongs but came up empty in the stretch. ALL THE MAGIC stalked the pace, was roused three wide to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch and weakened. TWO BUCKS TO WIN tracked the winner from the rail for six furlongs ten gave way.
