SMILE AGAIN broke cleanly and stalked the pace in hand three wide early, advanced into the second turn to challenge for command two wide, forged to the front entering the stretch, drew clear and won driving. GENERAL ROYAL was forced four wide while gaining a forward position into the first turn, advanced steadily on the backstretch to offer his best bid three wide on the second turn, finished steadily but could make no impact against the winner. KOSLANIN (ARG) hopped slightly at the start then quickly reach contention, raced unhurried to the second turn, offered a menacing bid four wide to the stretch and lost his punch. MOORE'S FLAT set the pace from off the rail and weakened once in the stretch. FUTURISTIC settled just off the lead and off the rail, seemed a bit rank advancing on the rail once on the backstretch, was shuffled back into the second turn, remained inside and in contention to the head of the lane then lacked a late response. NUMERO UNO lagged to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch and finished in a mild rally. KITTYS LINK showed little. JUST RULER settled inside, eased out for the second turn but had no rally. BROWNIE raced four and five wide throughout and failed to rally. GALAVANT prompted the pace early and gave out.
