**Footnotes**

SAINT IN A DRESS broke a bit slow dropped inside and lagged to the second turn, commenced her bid into the second turn, was fanned seven wide to the stretch, continued to respond and was up late. STORM THE NET was forwardly placed from the outset, raced two wide throughout, offered her bid into the stretch and was outdueled by the winner. BREEZE GAL checked into the first turn inside STARRY EYES and was forced four wide to the backstretch, commenced her bid into the second turn, was forced five wide to the stretch challenging for command and gave way in mid stretch. HOEDOWN'S CHILD settled on the rail, remained inside on the second turn to offer a menacing bid at the head of the lane then weakened. DIAMOND PLAY was unhurried early, tried to rally on the second turn, was fanned six wide to the stretch then lacked the needed response. WILD ROSE COUNTY had no rally. VICE 'N REASON was fanned five wide early. advanced steadily into the second turn, drifted five wide at the quarter pole and gave out. JANUARY GOLD was hustled to a clear early lead then stopped on the second turn. STARRY EYES bore out into the first turn while stalking the pace, remained a factor to the second turn and stopped while three wide.
