NINA WIN was allowed to settle for a half, rallied three wide and dueled for the lead on the second turn, inched clear to mid stretch then dug in gamely late to hold. QUAN'S GIRL saved ground early and settled, came three wide to the stretch then finished willingly late and grabbed the place. LILLY FA POOTZ stalked the pace to the half, bid two wide and dueled between rivals to the stretch, was outkicked to mid stretch then dug in but missed second. PRETORIAN FALLS had no speed and settled to the half, came two wide to the stretch, shifted out and responded once in the stretch but was in traffic in the final furlong and could not make a late run. GLACIER PEAK set the pace to the second turn, responded when hooked to the stretch, stayed on to deep stretch then was outfinished. JUST GET'ER DONE stalked the pace to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch then gave way. GULA GOLD was three wide early, settled to the second turn, was pushed out four deep to the stretch and gave way in the drive.
