**Footnotes**

BOLD MEETING was unhurried to the half, bid two wide into the second turn, closed with a burst of speed to the stretch, pushed clear to mid stretch and held driving despite not switching leads. NEW GENERATION was four wide to the backstretch, settled to the half, got fanned five wide on the second turn while advancing then closed ground steadily to the line. COULD BE DREAM'N also settled mid pack for a half mile, bid three then four wide to the stretch and was also gaining in the final furlong. COUNTRY IMPACT chased the pace to the second turn, offered his best rally three wide to the stretch then lost his punch in the final furlong. VADER GRADE contested the pace early then was outkicked by TUMBLING DICE MAN, responded to push past that on and edge clear on the second turn but tired through the drive. LOVINGTHISJACKPOT never far back to the half, lost position on the second turn then failed to respond late. AHH LOVER was four wide to the backstretch, settled to the second turn, advanced four wide to the stretch but also weakened through the lane. ALOHA D J had no speed, advanced inside leaving the half mile pole, was a factor to the stretch then tired. TUMBLING DICE MAN was sent for speed, edged away briefly on the backstretch but stopped after five furlongs.
