CIGAR MAN took back at the start and raced unhurried from the inside to the backstretch, commenced his bid from just off the rail on the second turn, shifted out for the drive, rallied outside SARATOGA BOOT at the furlong pole, closed steadily and was up in the final jump. HOT CHACO lagged from just off the rail early, offered a quick bid from the two path nearing the stretch, rallied to the lead in the deep stretch but could not quite stall the winner. OUR NAUTIQUE (NZ) set all of the pace from the inside, was challenged by SLEW THE MAN after five furlongs, disposed of that rival past the furlong pole to maintain an advantage but slackened deep in the stretch. SLEW THE MAN raced up outside pulling hard to challenge for the lead after five furlongs, dueled outside OUR NAUTIQUE into the stretch but weakened leaving the furlong pole. MASSONE settled early three wide, was fanned five wide on the second turn but never responded. SARATOGA BOOT stalked the pace two wide early, eased out three wide on the second turn but did not respond. INTERPATATION saved ground to no avail. AUTISM AWARENESS settled early off the pace, shifted four wide on the second turn and gave out.
