Footnotes

BOLD CHIEFTAIN was unhurried for a half mile, bid between rivals to the second turn, rallied two wide to the stretch, kicked clear to mid stretch and was kept to task late. CIGAR MAN had no speed and settled, bid two wide into the second turn, swung out five wide to the stretch then finished steadily for second. PEARL FISHER never far back for a half mile, shifted off the rail midway on the second turn while being roused then was outkicked to mid stretch and finished evenly. COVER MAGIC pressed the pace to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch but failed to make an impact in the drive. RUN IT stalked the pace to the half mile pole, got fanned four wide when trying to rally on the second turn and finished evenly. YACHT SPOTTER set the pace for six furlongs, was collared in upper stretch by the winner and gave way.
