MARIA'S FLAME tracked LA COLINA for the lead to the turn, rallied to that rival two wide at the quarter pole to take command, edged clear leaving the furlong pole and won driving. LOVE PETALS broke alertly then slipped back off the pace, rallied three wide into the stretch but lost her punch. PRINCESS LOU settled early, was three wide on the turn then did not respond. RED LAKE raced unhurried early, angled four wide on the turn and closed a gap too late. DIXIE ANN was permitted to settle between horses early, raced off the rail on the turn but never reached serious contention. LA COLINA raced up inside to take clear lead in the opening stages, gave way to the winner at the quarter pole, slackened then took a bad step after the finish and pulled up lame and was vanned off. JESI'S MAKIN MAGIC showed little. KEE NOODLE was never a factor.
