CAN'T TOPPER angled in once on the backstretch and tracked the pace from the rail to the turn, had room and rallied along the fence to push clear into the stretch then was kept to task late. MINER PIC had no speed and chased the pace to the turn, rallied three wide then shifted out into the stretch, closed steadily in the final furlong but was too late. FANCY SUMMER contested the pace to the turn, was off the rail and allowed the winner room inside, got collared by that one into the stretch and weakened. DREAM SPOTTER attended the pace outside of FANCY SUMMER, was three wide to the stretch then gave way. DELICATE DANCE prompted the pace to mid turn then tired. ENDLESS SWEEP slipped back in the early stages and was always outrun.
