**Footnotes**

ROSKO broke in stride and set the early pace from just off the rail, edged clear on the turn, met a bid from WHEELER GORGE nearing the furlong pole but responded and drew clear to win driving. WIN MACHINE lacked good early speed, raced two wide on the turn and finished willingly. MARCASSIN stalked the pace three wide into the stretch but lacked a closing response. WHEELER GORGE was well placed early from the outside, rallied three wide into the stretch to loom a factor at the furlong pole then flattened out. IBDANCINGTOO was slow early, raced in the two path on the turn and failed to rally. OUR SMOKIN HERO saved ground to no avail. GREEN BERET stalked the pace early and gave way between foes on the turn.
