Footnotes

APOLLO'S LEGACY broke alertly and was quickly in front, set the pace from just off the rail to the stretch, responded when set down for the drive and held under steady urging. MYSTICAL MARK prompted the pace to the turn, was outkicked to the stretch while saving ground then finished willingly in the final furlong but pulled up lame after the finish and was vanned off. ELECTROLYTE stalked the winner to the turn, was between rivals to the stretch then got outfinished in the final furlong. BROCK SAYS was bumped and jostled between IN A WINE TIZZY and KAMA SU at the start, trailed to the turn, swung out five deep into the stretch but could not make an impact late. EL TIO FERNANDO was also chasing to the turn, saved ground to the stretch but could not muster the needed late response. IN A WINE TIZZY got outsprinted early, swung out four wide into the stretch but also did not rally. KAMA SU chased the pace to the turn, raced three or four wide to the stretch then weakened in mid stretch. MONSAJEM MIMESIS pressed the pace to the turn, offered a bid three wide to the stretch but tired in the drive.
