Footnotes

PETERS PUNKIN tucked in behind the dueling leaders, tracked the pace to the far turn, was outside a rival and came two wide to the stretch, found herself blocked briefly in upper stretch, angled in sharply for an opening at the furlong marker, rallied to the lead then drifted out late but held. SISTER MARY HUGH saved ground to the half, shifted out then was fanned five wide into the stretch but continued to rally in the drive and was along for the place. ITALIAN WINE dueled for the lead to the half, responded to urging to the stretch but was outrun in the final furlong. RUBY MONTANI had no speed, advanced four wide to the stretch then could not make an impact late. PERFECT PLAN stalked early in the proceedings, pulled to duel for the lead on the backstretch, responded three wide on the second turn, remained a factor to mid stretch but weakened late. CHECK HER OUT was unhurried while saving ground to the second turn, rallied when asked to the stretch, was just behind the winner and had to check from that one's heels in mid stretch then finished evenly. ONE GOLDENGIRL dueled for the lead from the rail to the backstretch, was permitted to fall back a bit and tracked to the far turn, saved ground to the stretch and also had to check briefly in mid stretch away from CHECK HER OUT. UP ON HER TOES was fractious in the gate and threw her rider twice, was re-loaded then lunged at the start and was not a factor.
