Footnotes

NORTH STAR FAME gained a forwardly position from off the rail on the first turn and stalked the pace, moved up two wide and between foes into the second turn, was steadied and shuffled back slightly near the three eighths pole, recovered quickly and again was sent up three wide to be challenging for command into the stretch and proved best in the drive. BI TOMORROW raced unhurried to the second turn, offered a quick bid four wide to vie for the lead at the quarter pole, led into the stretch then could not match strides with the winner. HE'S A SURE CALL stalked the pace three wide from the outset, offered his bid three then two wide on the second turn but weakened in the lane. EXTRA HOT lagged early from the inside, came four wide on the second turn but lacked a closing response. WILD STING was without early speed from the rail, moved up three wide on the second turn but lost his punch once in the stretch. NO LOOKIN' BACK settled early then saved ground to no avail. STEAMIN OLY was close up early from off the rail and gave way three wide on the second turn. OLYMPIC PIRATE set the pace from the inside to the second turn and stopped.
