SIX PACK ABS was settled to the turn, raced between rivals in the two path to the stretch, responded when roused and eased out for room into the stretch, closed with a strong rally and won going away. DESIGNER BREED had no speed and trailed to the stretch, also eased out in upper stretch and found a clear path then closed ground to the line. GOLD LABEL had no speed, came three wide to the stretch then finished evenly to the wire. HARAKA HARAKA set the pace to the stretch, responded to mid stretch but tired in the final sixteenth. BABCOCK LAKE pressed the pace two wide to the stretch but weakened through the drive. COLERYAN chased the leaders to the turn, got fanned four wide while trying to rally into the stretch and slackened in the final furlong. SHEM tracked the pace from the rail to the stretch but came up empty when asked. QUITEN BOY was outrun to the turn then saved ground to no avail. HOLIDAY HARBOR stalked the pace to the turn, was asked for speed three wide mid turn but gave out in the stretch.
