Footnotes

QUINNETTE was a pace factor from the outset, raced two wide to the stretch, edged away to mid stretch then held driving. A RACING DELIGHT chased the leaders to the turn, bid two to mid turn, eased three wide to be clear of the leaders into the stretch then finished willingly without threatening the winner. OVER MARKETED tracked the pace to the turn, got fanned out four wide while outside the runnerup into the stretch then also was making a belated bid. ARTEMIDA bumped with RISKY ALLURE at the start then flashed the good speed, dueled inside the winner to the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. PRESCIOUS was outsprinted early and chased to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch then did not make an impact late. RISKY ALLURE was bumped by ARTEMIDA and bobbed at the start and was not a factor.
