**Footnotes**

EXECUTIVE SWEET broke alertly and raced close up from the outset, advanced four wide on the turn to be challenging for command in the upper stretch, took the lead at the furlong pole and drew clear driving. DANA SISSTAR was permitted to settle early, became fanned five wide on the turn, rallied into the lane but flattened out in the final furlong. ROLL MODEL set the pace from off the rail into the stretch and gave way readily once headed by the winner. CURVEY STAR lacked good early speed, tried to rally five wide on the turn but lacked the needed response. ALL THE RAGE was without early speed, angled four wide into the lane but failed to rally from between horses. SEA YA WAGER stalked the pace from the rail to the turn and gave way. DRASTIC TACTICS was void of early speed, saved ground into the lane but failed to reach serious contention. HAAS'N ALIBI tracked ROLL MODEL from the inside to the head of the lane and came up empty. STAR'S PROMISE lacked early speed, raced six wide on the turn and the rider dropped his whip entering the stretch. STORMIN LASS tracked the pace from between horses to mid turn and gave out.
