STATELY APPEAL broke in stride and dueled between horses to the stretch, edged clear a furlong out and held driving. OLD WAY raced unhurried early, saved ground on the turn and rallied late between foes. MISS OLIVIA K was never too far back, loomed two wide in the upper stretch but went evenly late. RACHEL RACCOON lagged early, angled four wide in the lane and closed well from the extreme outside. CASHMERE MIST was permitted to settle early, set out after the leaders four wide to seem a bold factor nearing the furlong pole then hung late. COUNTRY GOLD dueled from the inside to the upper stretch and weakened. TRUFFLE N PARADISE was not asked for speed early, raced two wide on the turn and finished well but too late. SMOOCH dueled three wide into the stretch and gave out.
