MOMMY GO TOO settled behind the pace in the early stages, was roused nearing the second turn, rallied three wide then had to circle rivals four wide into the stretch, finished determinedly in the final furlong and was up in time. FARMER GILES (IRE) stalked the leaders for five furlongs, rallied three wide to engage for the lead on the second turn, kicked clear in mid stretch then could not hold. WESTERN ROSES was a pace factor from the outset, dueled inside for six furlongs, got outkicked in upper stretch but kept to task and stayed close to the line. THUNDERCLAP NEWMAN had no speed, trailed to the stretch while three wide then closed the gap without threatening. SUDDEN EXCESS contested the pace outside of WESTERN ROSES for six furlongs, remained two wide to the stretch, was also outkicked in upper stretch and weakened. STRIKINGLY SINFUL had no speed and was not a factor.
