RESIST broke alertly and dueled inside MOJAVE MANDATE to the stretch, responded and drew clear driving. RON'S RANGER was permitted to settle early, raced two wide on the turn, finished steadily but could not threaten the winner. CROCKER'S CORNER lagged to the turn, circled rivals four wide into the lane and closed willingly. HARLAN'S HALO lacked good early speed, saved ground to the stretch, remained inside for the drive and came on. MOJAVE MANDATE dueled outside the winner to the stretch and weakened. CHOOVIO stalked the pace three wide to the stretch and slackened. CEE'S TREASURE was well placed to the turn then faded two wide.
