Footnotes

ROCK 'N RULE was settled to mid turn, bid three wide then was fanned four deep into the stretch, raced widest in the drive and closed determinedly late to be along in time. DRAW TWO BUCK tracked the pace to the turn, shifted out three wide and rallied to duel for the lead in mid stretch, battled to deep stretch then was caught in the late stages. NATURAL DREAMS was a pace factor two wide to the stretch, fought the runnerup for the lead to deep stretch then was outfinished late. FREE DIME TRICK was allowed to settle just inside the winner to the turn, came two wide to the stretch, made a good run to mid stretch but lost his punch in the final sixteenth. MR MUNSEY stalked the leaders to the turn, was fanned out four wide while rallying into the stretch, loomed boldly a furlong out but also could not sustain the needed response. SEEKING ROSES pulled in the early stages and was up to duel for the lead from the rail to the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. WINNER IN OVERTIME tracked the pace to the turn, dropped back to the stretch then was eased in mid stretch but walked off.
