EVENING MEETING broke alertly and took a clear early lead from the inside on the first turn, set all of the pace under even rating, drifted in slightly approaching the furlong pole but was quickly straightened, continued to respond and held on determinedly. KISSING GIRL (ARG) was permitted to settle early between horses, raced behind traffic from off the rail on the second turn, dropped inside for the drive, checked briefly approaching the furlong behind the winner then came on gamely to just miss. HOOKED ON NINERS raced unhurried early from the extreme outside, remained four wide on the second turn and closed willingly in the lane. REDMOND prompted the winner two wide into the stretch and slackened. NEON QUEEN was never too far back, saved ground to the stretch but lacked the needed response. SASSY CONDUCTION broke slow, dropped inside on the first turn while well back, continued to save ground on the second turn but did not rally. MY FIRST LADY stalked the pace three wide for six furlongs and slackened. STE. PECHERESSE raced close up early three wide then did not respond on the second turn. AUSSIE GIRL trailed throughout. The rider aboard KISSING GIRL lodged an unsuccessful objection against the winner for alleged interference in the final sixteenth
