SANGER SILVER broke a step slow but pulled his way to contention in the opening quarter, remained under patient handling into the turn, came through inside MARK THE BENCH at mid turn, eased outside into the lane, rallied to REAGAN REPUBLICAN nearing the furlong pole and edged clear driving. MAGNIFICENT BLEND raced unhurried early, came three wide to the stretch and finished steadily. HEXBREAKER was well positioned just off the pace, was forced four wide on the turn and lost his punch in the late stretch. REAGAN REPUBLICAN was quickly in stride to set the pace from off the rail, drew clear on the turn but slackened once in the stretch. PREMIUM QUALITY lagged early, advanced two wide into the stretch, lacked room briefly at the three sixteenths and again briefly at the furlong pole, then came on until lacking room late and checked. UNVARNISHED was void of early speed, raced in the three path into the stretch and finished in a mild rally. VELIKIY ZEVS saved ground to no avail. MARK THE BENCH prompted the pace from the inside, drifted out on the turn and came up empty after a half mile. STREET CAR stalked the pace but failed to respond while three wide on the turn.
