Footnotes

TOBIAH'S JOURNEY was unhurried behind the clear leader to the second turn, rallied two wide to the stretch then finished steadily to deep stretch, caught MURRAY THE COP and held despite tiring. MURRAY THE COP sped to a long lead on the first turn, maintained a sizable advantage to the stretch then tired in the drive and could not hold off the winner while saving second. HOT TUB AARON was settled in the opening half, got fanned four wide on the second turn then closed the gap in the stretch and got the nod for the show. OUR WOODY was four wide on the first turn, settled for a half mile, bid three wide to the stretch then was also gaining late without threatening seriously and just missed third. MY ECONOMIC PLAN was also settled in the opening half mile, raced three wide on the second turn but could not make a serious run in the stretch. TURBULENT CREEK trailed to the stretch and was not a factor. COLE IS THE MAN had no speed and was outrun.
