MTN RANCH WILLY broke alertly and stalked the pace from the outside, gained command two wide on the turn, drew clear in the upper stretch and won driving. QUICK MEETING tracked the pace from the inside, shifted out for the drive but lacked the needed response. MUTAK GOLD raced unhurried early, was fanned four wide on the turn and finished steadily. PAPA DO RIGHT lacked good early speed, saved ground to the stretch, shifted out and finished willingly. PUNCH UP bumped hard with DAVOS at the start to fall behind, came two wide on the turn and closed a gap. DAVOS bumped hard with PUNCH UP at the start, steadied and became rank to fall far back, trailed into the lane but finished full of run. MCMURTRY broke inward then settled, was three wide on the turn but failed to respond. TRITIUM settled early but failed to respond while four wide on the turn. WARREN'S PEPE was well placed early, commenced his bid three wide and between horses at the quarter pole but lost his punch once in the stretch. HARAKA HARAKA set the pace from the inside to the quarter pole and stopped.
