CHIEF INSPECTOR stalked the leaders to the turn, rallied four wide to the stretch, battled the runnerup through the final furlong and bested that one in the late going. GOLD STAR chased to the turn, was caught out five wide while rallying into the stretch, stuck a head in front in mid stretch then fought the winner to deep stretch but was outfinished. ONLY TOP MONEY also chased the pace to the turn, saved ground to the stretch then shifted out and was making up ground belatedly. PADDY'S POT'O GOLD was outsprinted, raced two wide to mid turn, swung out four wide into the stretch and also was gaining in the late stages. WHAT LOYAL WANTED was slow to find a comfortable stride and lagged to the turn, was three wide to mid turn then was forced out five wide into the stretch but could not muster the needed response. HICKOK was hustled, set a pressured pace to the stretch while racing off the rail then tired in the drive. IPPON pressed HICKOK to the turn, was three wide to the stretch but gave way in the lane.
