SO SO FAST was outprinted to the turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, pushed to the front a furlong out and drove clear late. CANALASSO chased the leader early, was crowded and bumped by MINNEWAWA leaving the half, drifted inward slightly and brushed with that one nearing the three eighths, came two wide to the stretch, was outkicked to mid stretch but kept to task and was up for second. HOW NOW set the pace, edged clear under urging on the turn while racing off the rail but was collared in mid stretch and tired. PEPPER CALI broke a step slow and trailed to the turn, shifted three wide mid turn, rallied to mid stretch the flattened out. MINNEWAWA tracked the pace early, came out and crowded the runnerup at the half mile pole, was in turn crowded by that one and checked at the three eighths, got outkicked to the stretch then made a bit of run in the late stages. LUCKY TO STAY HOME pressed the pace from the rail to the stretch but weakened through the final furlong. A claim of foul by the rider on MINNEWAWA against CANALASSO for alleged interference nearing the three eighths pole was not allowed by the stewards.
