LUCKY AT MIDNIGHT broke a bit awkwardly and was outrun to the half, commenced a bid nearing the second turn, made a stout run three wide to the stretch, continued to respond in the drive, got by MEMO TO MAGGIE late and held. ELAINA'S PAPOU had no speed and was towards the rear to the second turn, had the winner outrun her into the second turn, rallied three wide to the quarter pole, eased inwards in upper stretch and continued her rally but was outfinished in a game try. MEMO TO MAGGIE set the pace for six furlongs, was pressured by the favorite on the second turn, dueled that one to mid stretch, could not stall the winner late and was bested by the runnerup. PRINCESS NAYIRI prompted the pace in hand to the half, bid two wide on the second turn, drew alongside MEMO TO MAGGIE into the stretch, dueled that one to mid stretch but tired through the final furlong. WHAT A TWIT chased the pace to the half, was two wide on the second turn but gave way through the stretch. DOINGTHERIGHTTHING was settled inside for a half, continued to save ground to the stretch but gave out.
