WELCOME HOME RYAN was pinched between THEY CALL HIM EL and QUAIL HILL at the start and checked, was outrun for five furlongs, rallied four wide on the second turn then continued to respond in the drive and edged clear. SANDOR (GB) chased the leaders to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch then shifted out and was closing ground late to catch THEY CALL HIM EL for the place despite not switching leads. THEY CALL HIM EL tracked the pace to the second turn, made a good rally three wide to push to the front in mid stretch but was tiring in the final sixteenth. MICHAEL THE MAN had no speed and trailed to the second turn, raced four wide to the stretch then finished steadily without menacing. KISSN TRISTAN stalked the leaders to the half mile pole, was outrun by rivals on the second turn and came up empty. SHOWME YOURFRIENDS was three wide to the backstretch, pressed the favorite to the second turn but had little left for the drive. QUAIL HILL broke inward and crowded the winner at the start, was a pace factor for six furlongs but tired and gave out through the stretch.
