Footnotes

BUYMEABOND raced up inside to dispute the lead from the outset, continued to battle into the stretch, responded and gradually edged clear at the furlong pole and held driving. SAN SEBASTIAN lagged early from the inside, raced two wide on the second turn, entered the lane in traffic but rallied willingly. JOE HARDOON pressed the pace three wide early, challenged two wide on the second turn, dueled to the upper stretch and gradually faded. SANIBEL SID settled early two wide, was forced four wide on the second turn and came on without being a serious factor. OLYMPIC GOLDDIGGER was unhurried early, raced four wide on both turns but lacked the needed response. CALL HIM PADDY lagged early off the rail then saved ground on the second turn but could not reach serious contention. TRICE UP tracked the pace three wide early, was fanned four wide on the second turn and gave way. FASTER THAN DUKE was well position two wide for six furlongs and gave out. VANTAGE POINT flashed only brief speed. MISTIC MAN was never a factor. BOMB SITE stalked three wide and stopped into the stretch.
