Footnotes

BLUE CAY never far back while trailing to the second turn, saved ground while rallying to the stretch, found room inside of PLAYING 'R SONG into the stretch, responded when clear and drove to the lead late. PLAYING 'R SONG set the pace to the half, responded and edged clear on the second turn, remained clear to mid stretch but could not stall the winner. AWESOME BEGINNING tracked the pace from the rail to the second turn, remained inside to the stretch but could not muster the needed response. IRISH LINEN was settled to the half, made a bid two wide to the stretch then finished evenly in the drive. MODERATION prompted the pace to the half, was asked for speed three wide on the second turn but lacked a late bid. THE EMSTER stalked the pace to the half, was caught four wide while attempting to rally on the second turn then flattened in the lane. LEREYEV was unhurried to the half, advanced three wide on the second turn, was forced to circle six wide into the stretch then lost her punch in the drive. LUVOLE' settled mid pack to the half, was caught four wide on the far turn and gave out in the drive.
