SHOW OFF stalked the leader from off the rail to the second turn, raced two wide to the stretch, rallied to take over inside the furlong grounds, inched away to the sixteenth marker but was all out to hold on late. CHIN'N TONIC (IRE) set the pace while three wide, was four wide down the backstretch and on the second turn, responded into the stretch, was overtaken in mid stretch but fought back late. EL TANGO RAY lagged to the second turn, raced three wide to the stretch then rallied through the final furlong. FLYING MARINE was allowed to settle, bid two wide to the stretch then also was gaining late while being outfinished by EL TANGO RAY. FISHING MY WAY chased the leader to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch and was also making up ground belatedly. NOTJONNY had no speed, settled to the half, bid three wide on the second turn but tired through the drive. IDOITMYWAY BABY chased the pace early, was outkicked to the second turn, tired then was not persevered with in the stretch.
