VEGAS BURN stalked the pace to the turn, saved ground to the stretch, rallied to engage for the lead a furlong out, dug in gamely and edged away in the final sixteenth. SEEK THE HEAT set the pace from off the rail, was collared into the stretch, responded to mid stretch then was outkicked by the winner but saved second. RIDICULO pressed the pace to the turn, came three wide and rallied to join the leaders in mid stretch then was also outfinished by the winner and missed second. WE CAN BE HEROES chased the pace from the rail to the stretch then finished steadily late without threatening. PROUD BULL was also chasing to the turn, came three wide to the stretch, brushed OUR WORTHYENDEAVOR in mid stretch and finished evenly. DEVIL'S SAINT was bumped by OUR WORTHYENDEAVOR at the start and was away a bit slow, shifted outside rivals and chased to the turn, raced three wide and rallied to the stretch, dueled to mid stretch but was tiring in the final sixteenth. OUR WORTHYENDEAVOR broke inward and bumped DEVIL'S SAINT at the start, was hustled early, chased to the turn, came four wide to the stretch but lacked the needed late response.
