### Footnotes

CHINA PRINCE took command in the opening stages and set all of the pace from off the rail under good rating, responded in the stretch and drew clear driving. TIZ FITTING tracked the winner from the inside throughout, finished steadily but could make no impact against the winner. STAR ROCKER settled early three wide, moved up from the four path on the second turn to loom a factor once in the lane but hung in the final furlong. UNUSUAL MEETING was not asked for speed to the second turn then closed willingly from the inside. TENANGO was permitted to settle from the rail early, raced two wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. MANDALA was well positioned from off the rail to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch but failed to rally. GHOST SEEKER lagged early, was four wide on the second turn and failed to threaten. DE ANGELO stalked the winner from the three path for six furlongs and came up empty. COHIBA CAT was never a factor. VERY SPENSIVE was always outrun then was eased in the stretch.
