Footnotes

ROBS HERO was permitted to settle into the first turn while saving ground to the backstretch, commenced his bid two wide on the second turn, swung out for the drive, rallied steadily to gain command late and won going away driving. GAMBLING MAN drifted a bit wide on the first turn then settled, came two wide on the second turn and finished in a mild rally. FEST TIMES GEAR tracked the dueling leaders from off the rail early, offered his best bid three wide into the stretch but slackened late. STALKING GOLD lagged early from off the rail, came three wide on the second turn and was gradually gaining. STEADFAST STEVE dueled inside SILVER HELMET to the stretch, edged clear briefly leaving the furlong pole but faded in the late stages. SILVER HELMET dueled two wide into the stretch and weakened. BACARDI RUN broke out on the first turn to fall behind, remained out on the second turn and did not respond. THE FLYN'JACAMACOO stalked the leaders from off the rail to the second turn and gave way. PHANTOM WARRIOR drifted out on the first turn then settled, raced four wide on the second turn and failed to rally. IRISH HARMONY was rank into the first turn then bolted and was never a factor.
