Footnotes

MOSCATO gained a forward striking position from the rail early then raced unhurried to the second turn, eased off the rail into the lane, rallied to the lead past the furlong pole, edged clear then was all out to hold. SMOOTH AND SAVVY lagged to the second turn, came through inside to reach serious contention once in the stretch, shifted outside the leaders near the sixteenth pole and closed with good determination to just miss. OKIE DOKIE PETEY set all of the pace from the inside, was headed at the quarter pole but kept gamely to his task in the lane in a good try. NSYNC LYNX checked off BOXELDER on the first turn but quickly recovered and stalked the pace, moved up outside OKIE DOKIE PETEY on the second turn to challenge for command, dueled to the deep stretch and slackened. PLATINUM KATILLAC took back in the opening stages and trailed to the second turn, advanced three wide to the stretch and finished steadily. HE DID settled early while three wide, moved up four wide on the second turn but had little left for the drive. ROCKY ROAD settled early from the rail then had no response while three wide on the second turn. BOXELDER bore out into the first turn, settled and prompted the pace to the second turn then stopped and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
