Footnotes

DIRECTOR'S CUT set all the pace to the second turn, responded to pressure to mid stretch then was under steady urging to the line. YOU'RE NO GOOD prompted the pace from the rail to the stretch, could not impact the winner but outfought TOPAKI gamely for the place. TOPAKI was allowed to settle for a half mile, saved ground on the second turn, moved up to loom a threat to mid stretch but hung in the final sixteenth. NEW GENERATION drifted four wide on the first turn, settled on the backstretch, tried to rally three deep on the second turn but went evenly late. VADER GRADE broke a step slow and had no speed then saved ground to no avail. LOVINGTHISJACKPOT pressed the pace from the two path for six furlongs then gave way. OUTSHOUT tracked the pace to the second turn but gave out through the drive.
