RUSSIAN GREEK was content to trail for five furlongs, rallied two wide on the second turn then shifted to the rail in mid stretch, closed willingly and surged to the front late. MARSHAL MARINI was forced out six wide by LUCKY CULPRIT on the first turn, straightened and was settled to the second turn, rallied four wide to engage for the lead into the stretch, kicked away to mid stretch then failed to switch leads in the drive and was overtaken in the late stages. BLACKY THE BULL was hustled to the front and dueled for the lead early, inched away on the backstretch, again dueled SQUID on the second turn, was outkicked by the runnerup to mid stretch and finished evenly. CAHILL CHROME was rank and trying to get out to the first turn then lugged out nearing the thirteen sixteenths and forced LUCKY CULPRIT out into MARSHAL MARINI, tracked the leaders to the second turn, offered a good bid three wide then was in tight while drifting inward leaving the quarter pole, checked then could not regain the needed momentum. SQUID vied for the lead outside of BLACKY THE BULL for six furlongs but tired in the drive. LUCKY CULPRIT was bumped and forced out sharply mid way on the first turn then was pulled up and vanned off.
