LUCKY AFFAIR was quickly in front and clear, set all of the pace, drew off into the stretch and extended her advantage driving. MARY WANNA BE was always forwardly placed, came three wide to the stretch to gain the place without bothering the winner. PLANET JANET settled early, raced four wide on the turn and was never a serious threat. KASEY K prompted the winner from the outside to the stretch and gave way. TRUCKEE BABY lacked early speed, was two wide on the turn and passed only tiring horses. AMBEDEUX was void of any early speed then saved ground to no avail. BONGO DANCER settled early, was in the two path on the turn but came up empty. DANCEUNDERTHESTARS had some speed from the rail, stopped on the turn and was eased in the stretch.
