NEWPORT LULU broke in stride then was permitted to settle just off the dueling leaders, moved to that pair three wide into the stretch, drew clear and was ridden out to the line. STORMIN LASS dueled outside PERFECT JOURNEY in hand to the head of the lane, finished steadily but was no match for the winner. COTTONWOOD BABE was permitted to settle early then saved ground and came on but failed to be a major factor. WATCH THIS GAL settled early then failed to respond while three wide on the turn. PERFECT HONEY dueled from the rail to the head of the lane and stopped. HIGHLY ATTACHED steadied after the start to fall behind then rushed to contention but came up empty while four wide into the stretch. CANDEYE LOU steadied at the start and fell behind then saved ground but failed to respond. GIFT TO BOB had no speed.
