Footnotes

ALABAMA BOY was void of speed to the second turn, circled rivals four wide into the lane, quickly challenged for command at the furlong pole but did not get by until the final stages. JACKPOT SALOON broke alertly then was taken under a snug hold and remained unhurried to the second turn, rallied three wide into the stretch, gained command at the furlong pole and dueled gamely until headed late. COWBOY HEART set the pace from the inside to the second turn, drifted out into the lane, bumped DEACON SPEAKIN near the furlong pole and slackened. DEACON SPEAKIN' dueled outside COWBOY HEART throughout, was floated out into the lane, was bumped by that rival and weakened. KEYNIENTOS settled early from the rail, raced two wide on the second turn and failed to rally. NORTHERN J C settled early then failed to rally from the inside. Following a stewards inquiry COWBOY HEART was disqualified from third and placed fourth for interference to DEACON SPEAKIN in the stretch.
