FANTASTIC NIGHT drifted inward in the early stages and tightened things up for OLD COLLEGE TRY and SHILOH'S PAC BOOM, prompted the pace from the two path to the quarter pole, drew alongside GOLDEN GAYLORD into the stretch, inched away from that one to mid stretch and held driving. SAXMAN checked behind the leader leaving the five eighths, stalked the pace to the turn, saved ground to the stretch then could not catch the winner while best of the rest. SHILOH'S PAC BOOM was crowded by FANTASTIC NIGHT and forced to steady entering the backstretch from the chute, tracked the pace three wide to the stretch then finished willingly late. GEARING UP tracked the pace to the turn, bid two wide to the stretch but finished evenly late. GOLDEN GAYLORD was hustled, set the pace to the quarter pole, could not stall the winner to mid stretch and tired. OLD COLLEGE TRY was also crowded and forced to steady in the early stages, had no speed, raced three then four wide to the stretch but lacked a closing response. PEANUT BUTTER BOY trailed throughout.
