Footnotes

GLOBAL STAGE was never too far back while racing just off the rail, moved up four wide into the stretch to gain command at the furlong pole, drifted in late and bumped repeatedly with DO IT ALL and just held. DO IT ALL raced well placed from the inside early, remained under patient handling on the second turn, came off the rail into the lane for room, dropped back inside near the furlong pole, rallied gamely then was put in tight quarters by the winner late and was bumped repeatedly in the final sixteenth and just missed. KINGMAN KID was not asked for speed early while racing just off the rail, angled three wide on the second turn and rallied willingly through traffic in the stretch. HIGHWAY BANDIT lagged early from the inside, moved outside into the second turn, was fanned six wide into the stretch, the rider dropped his whip near the three sixteenths pole and lost his punch late. THE HUNT IS ON was not asked early, came through inside on the second turn, eased out near the furlong pole and rallied steadily. MANITOGA was permitted to settle in the early going from the rail, moved out for the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and flattened out. RED COATS R COMIN set all of the pace from off the rail into the stretch then gave way. DRESS CODE hopped at the start to be off three lengths slow, raced unhurried to the second turn then lacked the needed response four wide into the stretch. BARREL KNOT pressed the pace from the rail early, challenged two wide on the second turn but slackened once in the stretch. RINGOLEVIO stalked the pace three wide to the second turn and stopped. the stewards posted the inquiry and for interference in the final sixteenth, disqualified GLOBAL STAGE from first and place him second.
