POWERS LILSIS settled inside early and stalked the leaders well in hand, remained inside on the second turn, checked briefly off the heels of SING FOR GOLD nearing the stretch, quickly recovered and responded once straightened for the drive to rally to the lead and won driving. MERRY MARINO was unhurried early from off the rail, circled rivals five wide on the second turn to loom a bold factor a furlong pole but hung late. SING FOR GOLD prompted the pace two wide for six furlongs, took command in the stretch but slackened in the final furlong. MUSIC TEACHER settled early while three wide to the backstretch, advanced just outside the winner on the second turn but hung in the lane. RUCKUSING STORM was void of early speed from the outside, remained out on the second turn angled further out for the drive and lost her punch. LEAFY GREENS lagged early from the rail, entered the lane in the three path and passed tiring horses. HAVE'N A WILD TIME raced close up four wide, remained a factor from the outside on the second turn but came up empty in the lane. JIM N PEG'S GAL stalked the pace three wide for six furlongs and gave out. SARAH'S MELODY saved ground to no avail. CINNAMON GLO set the pace and dropped to the inside on the first turn, led to the head of the lane and stopped.
