Footnotes

FULL MOON LADY was urged early and showed speed to duel for the lead from the rail to the turn, responded to inch away to mid stretch then held under steady pressure. IT'S STEVIE'S TIME tracked the leaders while saving ground to the stretch, shifted off the rail in upper stretch and closed late. WHEN SHE SINGS was allowed to settle, raced two deep to the stretch then closed willingly in the final furlong. OUR MANGO was sent for speed and dueled from between horses to the stretch but weakened late in the drive. POWER TO BURN tracked the pace outside horses to the turn, was two wide to the stretch then lacked the needed late response. REMEMBER DOROTHY had no speed, saved ground to the stretch, shifted out for room but finished evenly. WOODFORD PRINCESS did not handle the going early and was lunging and leaping over puddles, fell back to last then could only pass tiring horses. COURTESTER was hustled early and dueled three wide to the turn, lugged out into the stretch then continued lugging out to the line. LITTLE BIRD was wide throughout and did not threaten. LEFA THEDA tracked the pace to the turn but stopped before going a half.
