PEPE LE FEU had no speed, was roused into the second turn, advanced two wide and was caught behind horses, checked then eased inside for room, rallied to the front in mid stretch and held driving. GLOBAL SUE was outrun to the half, rallied four wide on the second turn, dueled to mid stretch then was outfished to the line. REEL EVENT hopped at the start and had no speed, advanced two wide to the stretch but lost her punch in the final sixteenth. NO. ONE SUSPECT had no speed, advanced two wide when the leaders were coming back to the rest but weakened in the stretch. CANADIAN CHARM saved ground to the half, was roused nearing the second turn but was forced to circle five wide to the stretch and gave out in mid stretch. NORTHHOLLYWOOD ICE dueled outside of TRIBAL PRINCESS to the half, responded on the second turn but stopped through the stretch. ME A TEAZA chased the leaders to the half, rallied three wide and engaged for the lead on the second turn, dueled into the stretch but stopped in mid stretch. TRIBAL PRINCESS was hustled, showed speed to the second turn then stopped suddenly.
