Footnotes

ADVANCE TICKET broke alertly and tracked TOPPER'S SMLING, moved up to challenge that rival from the outside on the turn, took command once in the stretch then repelled a bid from KLEVEN'S VERBATIM at the furlong pole to win driving. KLEVEN'S VERBATIM settled early but was always within striking distance, advanced from the outside in the stretch to get to terms with the winner at the furlong pole then could not match strides. BRIAN'S MARK lacked good early speed, came three wide to the stretch but failed to rally. KENDRA RAE lacked good early speed, was impeded by the rider on DIXIELAND CLASSIC for several strides leaving the three eighths pole and steadied, then could not reach contention. TUSCAN PRINCESS settled in mid pace early but failed to respond while off the rail into the lane. TOPPER'S SMILING set the pace from the inside to the head of the lane and weakened. DIXIELAND CLASSIC bobbed in the early going and fell back, moved up into very tight quarters inside KENDRA RAE into the turn when the jockey lost his iron and slipped out of the saddle at the three eighths. As he was slipping off his horse the jockey on DIXIELAND CLASSIC hung on to the saddle of KENDRA RAE with his hand as his feet were still on his mount for several strides before falling completely off. The stewards posted the inquiry and reviewed the incident between DIXIELAND CLASSIC and KENDRA RAE but found the actions of the jockey on DIXIELAND CLASSIC in self defense as there was no room for him to fall after he lost his iron at the three eighths pole.
