LITTLE REHAAN emerged from between horses in the opening quarter to take a slim lead into the turn, disposed of WHAT WAS THAT on the turn to edge clear in the stretch and held driving. WOODFORD PRINCESS lacked good early speed, saved ground on the turn, shifted out for the drive and finished willingly two off the rail. BOLD CASCADE prompted the winner from the outset, offered her bid three wide into the stretch but lacked the needed response. FAIR WAGER tracked the leaders from the outside, remained four wide on the turn and did not rally. OVERJOYED was always forwardly placed from the extreme outside, followed FAIR WAGER on the turn then finished on even terms with that rival. REINA DE ORO was never a factor. LIL BARHOP broke slow and failed to reach contention. TRAPPER'SHABIT stumbled sharply at the start and had no speed. WHAT WAS THAT dueled the winner from the inside early and stopped.
