Footnotes

GAMBLIN TOWN was well placed off the leaders to the turn, rallied three wide and engaged for the lead in upper stretch, responded late to take over and drew clear under steady pressure. RICH DOMINO set a pressured pace to the stretch, responded when hooked in upper stretch, could not stay with the winner but dug in late to save the place. PROSPECTOR'S CROWN pressed the pace outside of RICH DOMINO to the stretch, was between horses and dueled briefly to the furlong grounds then weakened late. LOVEABLE MANDY stalked the pace from the rail to the stretch but finished evenly. BREANNA was allowed to settle, had her rider lose his whip mid way on the turn then lacked a closing response. MISTY B showed little. BLONDAGE was never a factor.
